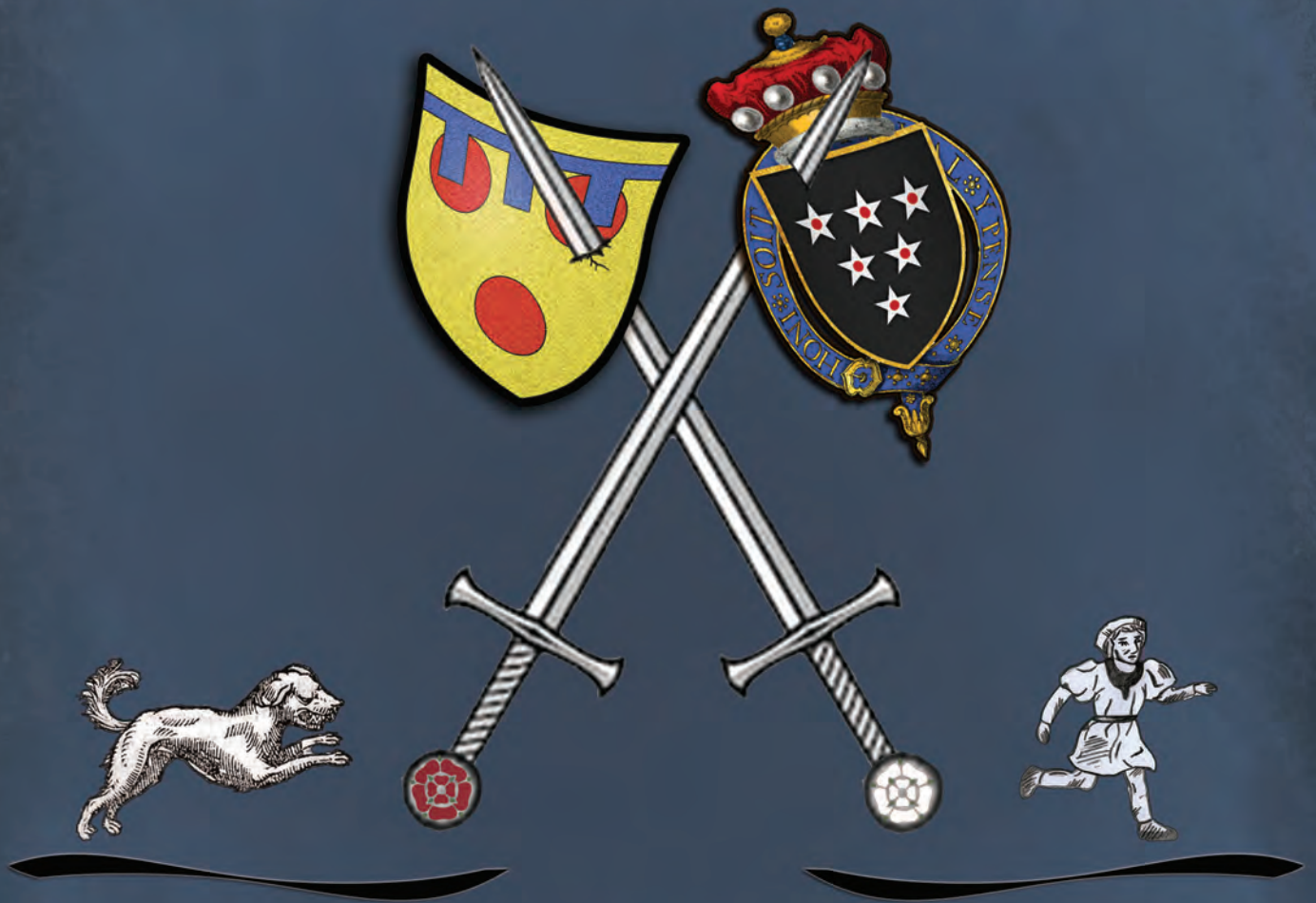

Devon in the 1450s - allegiances are divided between William Lord Bonville and the Earl of Devon, Thomas Courtenay senior, with his sons Thomas and Henry.
